Park & Ride Guide



This Park & Ride Guide is brought to you by Cruz511, a service of the Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission (RTC) working to provide you with access to goods, services and information through a wide range of travel choices.

You may park free in designated Park & Ride lots in order to meet your carpool, vanpool or to catch the bus.

Your cooperation in observing the following rules and safety tips is appreciated and will continue to make commuter use of these parking facilities possible.



Rules

- Park only in parking spaces specifically marked for commuters
- Pack your trash please don't litter
- Do not park vehicles that leak oil or other fluids
- Leave no trace behind don't walk, drive over or otherwise damage planted areas
- Vehicles in violation may be towed at the owner's expense
- Not responsible for theft, damage or personal injury. Park at your own risk!
- Hours vary so observe posted signs. Overnight parking is not allowed in several lots.

Park and Ride Safety Tips

- As with any public area, exercise common-sense security measures for yourself and your vehicle.
- Be observant, alert and aware especially after dark.
- Remember to turn off your lights, roll up your windows and lock your doors.
- Don't make your vehicle a tempting target. Always keep valuables out of sight.
- Take purses, cameras, computers and other valuable items with you.
- Have your keys ready when walking to your vehicle and keep your eyes open for people and moving vehicles.
- Report if something doesn't look right. If you see something...say something!
